Please describe how you would respond to the following circumstances.

A 4 year old child in a toy store asks for a toy that her parents have told you she may not have.

She will explain the baby that she can not have the toy because her parents told her before that she can not have it and if she cries she can play with her until she can relax herself and feel better.

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Two young children are fighting over a piece of candy.

She can cut the candie in two pieces and explain them that there is no reason to be fighting for a candie because they are brothers and that they need to love each other. Explain them that it is important to share.

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The Host Family asks you at the last minute to watch the kids while they go out that night. You have already made plans for that night with friends and the Host Family knew about your plans.

She says that it is not a problem to her cancel her plans and help the host family if they need.

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The 2 year old child you are caring for fell down and cut his chin, which is bleeding.

She will keep calm and take the child to a safe place and call immediatly to 911 for they can come and finally call his parents for they can come quickly.

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You believe the children you care for are not disciplined. You tell the host parents, but they don't seem to care.

She will try to discipline the child paying him attention all the time or helping him in everything that he needs. She will talk to him nicely for he can understand. She will explain him that his behavior it is not appropriate and telling him that there are different ways to ask for things.

Infant

She can play with the toys, dance with the baby, listen to music, read some books until the baby can fell asleep or for their estimulation. She can feed them, go to the doctor appointments if it is necessary and brush their hairs.

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Toddler

She can play with them, bath them, teach them letters and simple words, show them the colors, dance, listen to music, prepare the food for they can eat.

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4-6 years old

Play some sports, take short walks, play with them and their toys, cook them their favorite food, teach them numbers and letters, help them do their homework, teach them how to swim, go to the playground, to plan them playdates with another children.

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7-9 years old

She can help them do their homework, start talking them about good behaviors, take them to their afternoon activities, go to their swimming classes, practice some sports.

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10-12 years old

She can teach them good habits, give them good advice, help them in everything that they can need, pick them from school, go to the mall or the place they will need.

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Explain how to change a diaper step-by-step.

First she will take the old diaper, clean the baby with wipes, then put powder or cream and finally put the new diaper and dress the baby again.

Miryam understands everything and it is easy for her to let people know what she needs or if something is happening.

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
